Goals

- Provide access to assistive technology options to CSU students and employees

The Assistive Technology Resource Center (ATRC) works to ensure that CSU students and employees are aware of and have access to assistive technology options that allow for success in their respective educational and work roles. Most often, this is accomplished using adapted computing.

The ATRC offers the following services as part of their basic mission:

- **Assessments**
The ATRC provides adapted computing evaluations to determine a best match between the person, the environment, and the available assistive technology options.
- **Accommodations**
The ATRC determines and provides appropriate assistive technology accommodations.
- **Training**
The ATRC provides training in the application of the assistive technology.
- **Equipment Loans**
The ATRC provides assistive technology equipment loans to students.
- **Resources**
The ATRC provides access to assistive technology resources and information.
