

2007-2008 CAHS Mini Grants

The College of Applied Human Sciences is soliciting proposals for support of faculty **research, creative, and scholarship activities.**

Purpose: The monies are awarded to provide faculty with support to secure external funding (i.e., grant, contract, foundation, or development funding).

Budget: Awards of up to \$6,000 are possible. Joint applications by multiple individuals are acceptable. A total of \$36,000 is available. Budgets can be used for summer salary, graduate assistant support, pilot data collection, or other activities directly linked to an external funding opportunity.

Deadlines: Completed applications for the mini grant award competition are due to the CAHS Associate Dean for Research office by 5:00PM on Monday, January 14, 2008. Notification will be made in writing to applicants by Friday, February 22, 2008.

Priority: is given to resident instruction tenure track faculty in the event that there are more applications recommended for receiving funding than available awards.

Evaluation: The CAHS Research Committee (comprised of representatives from each department) will score the applications for scientific merit and alignment of the application with the relevant funding guidelines. They will submit recommendations for funding to the College Executive Committee (comprised of Dean April Mason, Jean Lehmann, Dale DeVoe, and Tom Mazzarisi) for final approval.
